

# Roadmap to Becoming a Certified Reiki Teacher

# I've completed my training. What's next?

Once you have completed levels 1, 2, and 3 of your Reiki training, you will be ready to take the next step: a proficiency exam.



# **Proficiency exam\***

The proficiency exam is administered for students who wish to become a Certified Reiki Teacher. It signifies the completion of your Reiki learning levels.

\*This exam is only for students who wish to pursue teacher training.

### Part 1

- This is a written exam
- The candidate must obtain 90% or more to pass
- The candidate has 100 minutes to write the exam
- Fee: \$198

### Part 2

- This is a practical exam
- The candidate must obtain 90% or more to pass
- This is a one-on-one interview-style exam
- Fee: \$528

# **Jyokyu Tasshi Designation Awarded**

Once you pass the exam, you are awarded the advanced practitioner designation and granted permission to offer Reiki healing to the general public as a JRA Certified Advanced Practitioner.

# **Teacher training begins**

Once you pass the exam, you are invited to complete teacher training. Depending on your schedule, learning style, and other considerations, the course duration can range from 1-6 months.

Cost: \$2,200



# Teaching proficiency test

- This is the final test
- It is to ensure the candidate is ready to begin teaching Reiki
- Fee: \$0

### JRA-Certified Reiki Teacher

Once you pass the final test, you will be awarded a certificate of Reiki Shihan to indicate that you are now a certified Reiki teacher via Japan Reiki Association (JRA). Congratulations!

### What does it mean to be a Reiki Shihan?

Reiki Shihan is a person who will provide attunement, as well as guide and instruct anyone who wishes to learn Reiki (more commonly known as a Reiki Master or Reiki Teacher).

Japan Reiki Association defines Reiki Shihan as "a person who will empower another person to shine their light from within."

At Japan Reiki Studio, we believe that anyone who...

- wishes to help another person shine to the best of their ability
- is moving towards 'perfecting the self'
- exudes happiness and/or lights up a room

...will succeed as a Reiki Shihan.

### Readiness Checklist

- 1. Can you immediately answer what you like about Reiki?
- 2. Do you tell people you practice Reiki or that you have learned Reiki? (If you are unable to talk to other people about Reiki, or feel that you lack confidence, you may not be ready to take the next step and become a teacher.)
- 3. Do you easily offer Reiki sessions to people who are not family or friends? (When you are able to offer a session without hesitation, you are likely ready to take the next step.)
- 4. Have you ever explained Reiki to someone who has no idea what Reiki is?
- 5. Have you sensed and then conveyed to your client (in words) what you felt during a Reiki session?
- 6. Are you able to explain what has changed for you with Reiki?
- 7. Do you know the difference between Reiki-ryoho and Reiki-ho?
- 8. Are you able to sense the difference in energy with each symbol?
- 9. Have more than 3 people expressed the wish to learn from you once you become a teacher?
- 10. Can you state at least 5 out of 11 reasons why you want the power of Reiki?
